At graduation each year, Cornerstone Charter Academy will recognize the valedictorian and salutatorian from the graduating class.

The student with the highest weighted cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) will be recognized as the valedictorian.

The student with the second highest weighted cumulative G.P.A. will be recognized as the salutatorian.

Beginning with the graduating class of 2026, ties will be accepted up to two students for each award. If there are more than two students tied for an award, the school will recognize one winner for each award. In the event that there are more than two students tied for either award, the student with the highest ACT from a single test session will break the tie.

#### **Photography Course Description**

Photography is a yearlong introduction to the digital camera/DSLR as an art-making tool designed for students at the beginning level. The course will use photography to help students learn and apply the basic elements of art and the principles of design. This course will also provide students with opportunities to extend their knowledge and skills in the field of photography. This course will familiarize the student with photographic equipment, materials, methods, and processes.
